The Sioux Nation Camp provides many opportunities for reaching out to the local Sioux community.



The Sioux Nation consists of many reservations scattered across South Dakota. TEAMEffort will be organizing youth mission trips on two of these reservations: The Pine Ridge Reservation in the Southwest region. Groups will have the opportunity to reach out to these struggling families through general home repairs and renovations. It is our goal your youth will demonstrate the love of Christ through their actions by building wheelchair ramps and re-roofing homes for these families in need.

Lodging: Groups will stay at a local facility in the surrounding area. The housing facility will include recreation areas and has shower facilities on the property.

Area Attractions: Black Hills Region, Badlands, Mount Rushmore, Custer State Park, and Crazy Horse Monument.

FAQ's

What do the mission sites at Sioux Nation look like?

Each group will be able to work in the Indian Reservation Community. There are plenty of opportunities within the Reservation to do construction on the local houses.

What meals are included at this camp?

All meals are provided Monday through Thursday and breakfast on Friday and Saturday. On Thursday evening, authentic Indian tacos are made for the groups from the community.

What activities are scheduled for the evenings?

TEAeffort has planned evening worship services geared directly for the youth with games, skits, videos, music and a message from one of the adult or college staff. For the Sioux Nation camp, we have a cultural night with a local Native Storyteller who shares stories about the Sioux Indians and their culture.

Will our group serve together on the mission site?

Yes, we will keep your group together. However larger groups may be put on multiple sites to make sure everyone is working.

What We Do

Logistics... We handle the details such as *mission sites, tools, food, lodging and programs* so you will have more time for fellowship, work and worship with your youth.

Programs and Music... Your group will grow from evening programs with challenging messages, skits, dramas, and contemporary praise and worship.

Tools & Materials Provided... All you have to bring is your group. Your mission site will be stocked with all of the tools and materials needed, so you can spend time working with your group instead of preparing your site.

Site Leadership... We have skilled and helpful supervisors on the mission sites to assist your group with the technical and practical aspects of the job.

Group Building... Your group will work together as a team to accomplish your youth mission project and will also get the opportunity to meet, interact and worship with youth from other groups. You only have to provide transportation for your own group, avoiding the liability of taking youth from other groups in your vehicles.

Staff... You will find an energetic, hardworking and fun staff at TEAeffort. They dedicate their entire summer to missions and are strong Christian role models for your youth. The staff will spend time building relationships with your group, working with them on the mission sites, organizing the games and activities, and leading worship at the evening services.
