Our Virginia beach location offers great outreach opportunities in the heart of the east coast life.



Along the Virginia coast there are many beautiful beaches and coastal towns, but you don't have to look too far inland to find communities that are struggling. In these areas, the homes of many elderly people and families on fixed incomes sit in disrepair. This summer youth groups will provide help to get their homes repaired and maintained, and offer hope by reaching out in Christian service. Work will include general home repair, painting, and deck and wheelchair construction.

Lodging: Groups will stay at Regent University Village in apartment-style dorms. Dining, meeting areas, and recreational facilities are located on site. Meals and evening Chapels are offsite at a local church. All meals are provided except two lunches and two dinners during free time.

Area Attractions: Beaches, Parks, Lighthouses, & the Virginia Aquarium. Nearby beaches and parks will be enjoyed for cook-outs, music, worship, and fun.

Where are the mission sites at this camp?

At the Virginia Beach camp, we have several options to reach out to this coastal community. We do construction projects which range from painting to building a front porch deck. Each homeowner enjoys the interaction with the youth & leaders.

What are the activities available at Virginia Beach?

At the housing facility, there is basketball, volleyball, and soccer available to play during free time.

Will our group serve together on the mission site?

Yes, we will keep your group together. However larger groups may be put on multiple sites to make sure everyone is working.

How close is our camp to the beach?

It takes about 30-40 minutes to drive to the beach from the housing facility. Since the area draws a lot of tourists, traffic can affect the driving time too.

What We Do

Logistics... We handle the details such as *mission sites, tools, food, lodging and programs* so you will have more time for fellowship, work, and worship with your youth.

Programs and Music... Your group will grow from evening programs with challenging messages, skits, dramas, and contemporary praise and worship.

Tools & Materials Provided... All you have to bring is your group. Your mission site will be stocked with all of the tools and materials needed, so you can spend time working with your group instead of preparing your site.

Site Leadership... We have skilled and helpful supervisors on the mission sites to assist your group with the technical and practical aspects of the job.

Group Building... Your group will work together as a team to accomplish your youth mission project and will also get the opportunity to meet, interact, and worship with youth from other groups. You only have to provide transportation for your own group, avoiding the liability of taking youth from other groups in your vehicles.

Staff... You will find an energetic, hardworking and fun staff at TEAMeffort. They dedicate their entire summer to missions and are strong Christian role models for your youth. The staff will spend time building relationships with your group, working with them on the work sites, organizing the games and activities, and leading worship at the evening services.
